

OHS SCHOOL UNIFORM:

Please see below the uniform requirements for 2018. All uniform items are available through Karam's Clothes in Opunake.

YEAR 13 AND 14 STUDENTS – GIRLS AND BOYS:

Year 13 and 14 students may wear mufti of an acceptable standard – this is a matter for each year's group to decide in consultation with the Principal and Staff.

Appropriate footwear must be worn in workshops, laboratories, gyms etc.

ALL STUDENTS

Polo Shirt	Blue – with OHS logo.
Trousers	Navy/black long dress trousers.
Shorts	Navy dress shorts.
Shoes	Plain black school shoes.
Sandals	Black or brown, low heel with some back support. – Term 1 & 4.
Jersey	Regulation long-sleeved "V" necked navy blue with gold neck band.
Scarf	Black or Blue and yellow striped – Term 2 and 3 and not to be worn in classrooms.
Jacket	Black regulation jacket – available from Karams Clothes.
Polar Fleece	Blue with gold trim.
T Shirts	Black/navy with no sleeves to be seen only to be worn under polo shirts.
Piercings	Cover facial piercings and all taonga to be discreetly worn.
Tattoos	All tattoos to be covered.
Earrings	Single set of studs/sleepers.
Hair	Natural colour.
Hats	School plain black/blue - Sun hats to be worn during lunchtime – Term 1 & 4 only.
Beanies	Navy or black – no logo – Term 2 & 3.

Girls:

All season Skirt	Blue/Navy/Gold regulation plaid, available from Karam's Clothes on the Coast.
Socks	White ankle socks.
Tights	Black to be worn with skirt only during winter Term 2 & 3.
Makeup	Discrete.

Boys:

Socks	Black ankle socks.
Facial Hair	Clean shaven.

All basic uniform items are available at Karam's Clothes on the Coast, Opunake
Physical Education and Games Wear - A suitable change of clothing, appropriate to the activity.

Playing Uniform for Sports Teams

Regulation playing uniform (details available from coaches) must be worn for all matches. Students representing the school in sports teams need to provide royal blue shorts (unless some other alternative is supplied by the school).
