ÖPUNAKĒ HIGH SCHOOL UNIFORM

All to be discreetly worn. Removed if requested for Health & Safety

Cover/remove facial piercings/earrings when required for Health & Safety

Tattoos Should be covered

Hair Clean and tidy, tied up when required for Health & Safety

Hats School plan black/blue – Sun hats to be worn during lunchtime

Physical Education and Games Wear

A suitable change of clothing, appropriate to the activity
